LEARNING DIALOGUES

I trust that all parents are in the know that **Learning Reports** were distributed to the students on Wednesday, April 2 and that tomorrow, Thursday, April 10 is the date for **Learning Dialogues**. Parent-teacher interviews are part of the fabric of North American schooling. King's has developed the dialogue format to also include the student in the conversation. Teachers gain significant insight into the learning process during the three-way conversation, especially when all participants are well-prepared for the meeting.

I would encourage students to take the opportunity to ask your teachers what you need to do to improve your grade by 10% - 15%. It is an opportunity to dis-

cuss your preferred learning style, to identify habits that could be changed or simply to applaud work well done. It is also an occasion for the teacher to praise the student, for the parent to applaud the work of the teacher, and for the student to show appreciation for the instructional help received from the teacher.

Although the meetings are brief, they provide all participants the renewed clarity of the purpose for the course and the learning that is expected.

From a teacher's point of view, the dialogues are formative in shaping the instruction for the remainder of the course. We look forward to meeting many parents tomorrow afternoon and evening.
