

A Christian Community

King's Christian Collegiate is determined to manage its financial affairs in a responsible manner, and as such, evaluates all fees on a regular basis. At the same time it is a King's strategic goal to ensure that a King's education is available to Christian families representing a wide range of incomes. King's has established a bursary program to assist families with lower incomes.

The fees charged cover the costs for daily operations as well as all principal and interest payments. The tuition charged is substantially reduced when compared to other private schools due to the generosity of many parents and community contributors who have donated \$7,000,000 towards the cost of the \$15,000,000 building. We praise God for their generosity.

Fee Structure

- Prior to full admission, all tuition payment arrangements must be completed.
- Prior to admission, each family is required to contribute \$3,500 to King's Christian Collegiate.
- A \$6,600 bursary is automatically provided to parents who enroll a second child. The net tuition for the second child is only \$4,500. Tuition for a third child is \$3,000.
- The tuition rates are reduced by 15% for full time King's staff and for families where one spouse is engaged in full-time church ministry.
- Each family is encouraged to retain membership in King's Christian Collegiate.
- International students must provide full payment with the admission application.

Conditions

- Tuition shall be payable in full at the rate set by the Board of Directors.
- Tuition payments shall be the responsibility of the parents or assignees registering the student(s) at King's.
- Tuition is an annual fee and payable as such, regardless of any absence by the student.
- Registration assumes enrollment until graduation unless you notify the Director of Admissions by May 15th that the student is not returning.
- Tuitions are not refundable unless there are extreme mitigating circumstances.
- Failure to comply with payment commitments will eventually result in a report to the Credit Bureau of Ontario.

Bursaries

King's Christian Collegiate provides bursaries to parents who desire a Christian education for their children but do not have sufficient financial resources at their disposal. The bursaries available are:

- Parents who have children enrolled at another Christian school where the annual fees are more than \$5,000 may apply for a \$1,000 bursary.
- All parents who enroll two children at King's Christian Collegiate automatically receive a \$6,600 bursary towards the tuition fee for the second child.
- Parents may apply for an additional bursary from the King's Endowment Fund. Application forms are available at the school office and on the web-site.
